Ways in which we are building citizenship:

Second Step and Little Spots Programs:

We are excited to implement the Second Step and Little Spots Programs, which focus on teaching social-emotional and executive functioning skills to our K-5 students.

Leadership Roles:

Students have opportunities to lead through roles such as grade 5 lunch leaders and hot lunch support which foster responsibility and leadership skills. We also embed student leadership opportunities within our daily and weekly classroom responsibilities, as well as jobs around the school that contribute to our collective wellness.

Pizza with the Principal

As a means of enhancing student voice within the building, we are running "Pizza with the Principal". Every Tuesday, a small group of students are chosen to come and have Pizza with Mrs. Croil This serves as an important role in getting to know all of the students, as well as creating a student roundtable discussions for the purpose of gathering feedback and information from a student perspective. All students will get this opportunity at some point in the school year as we are starting with our upper grades first.

Digital Citizenship:

We focus on teaching responsible technology use and promoting a safe online environment for our students. We have had our Division's Digital Wellness Team come to our grades 4 and 5 classes to help facilitate healthy dialogue around digital wellness.

Health and Wellness:

Encouraging balanced lifestyles through nutrition, physical activity, sleep, and hydration is a key part of our curriculum. Through our Nutrition Grant, we are able to ensure that all students have access to food throughout the school day.

Curriculum Connections:

Exploring leadership, perspectives, and developmentally appropriate current issues helps deepen students' understanding of citizenship and their roles within the community.

Cross Grade Groups:

Throughout the school building we have cross grade groupings which for students to connect with peers in different grade levels through active participation and responsible behavior within their school community, demonstrating qualities like respect for others, following rules, contributing positively, and showing concern for the well-being of their peers and school environment;
