Orange Shirt Day

On Monday September 29,
Lethbridge School recognizes
Orange Shirt Day. Orange Shirt Day
is a commemorative event held
annually to honour the children who
attended residential schools and
never returned home, as well as the
Survivors and their families. The day
promotes reconciliation by
encouraging Canadians to wear
orange shirts to acknowledge the
history and ongoing impacts of
residential schools and to affirm the
message that "Every Child Matters".



All General Stewart Students have a orange shirt that they can choose to wear on Monday. Our GS shirts were designed by students and our Indigenous Lead Teachers in 2024. The following is an overview of what each symbol represents and why they are on the shirts.

General Stewart Orange Shirt Day 2023-2024 Collaboration

Constellations: First Nations people used the stars as a map and have stories passed on for generations about the constellations.

Sweetgrass: one of the four sacred plants. Used for smudging, protection, and cleansing the mind. Sweetgrass / has anti-inflammatory properties.

The Spear: the speak represents the ingenuity of First Nations people and the various ways in which they harvested and hunted.

4 Triangles: Triangles are often use to symbolize children or people. The number 4 is very important in the Blackfoot culture. There are four seasons, directions, sacred plants, and four stages of life. When Blackfoot naming ceremonies take place, four stories are told before the name is given.

Sage: one of the four sacred plants.

Blackfoot people tend to use sage for smudging during mourning. Sage has anti bacterial properties and is/was used as a wash.

The Fire: the fire is an essential part of life. Fire provides smoke and heat to dry meat and hides. Provides heat for food and water and warmth. It provides light and protection from predators.

Infinity Symbol + Métis Sash: The infinity symbol and Métis Sash are symbols of Métis culture. The infinity symbol is on the Métis flag and symbolized the union of two cultures and celebrates that Métis culture will live on forever.
